



Help end the genocide in Gaza

The Gaza war could spark a war in the Middle East involving Iran and Saudi Arabia that has the potential to turn nuclear.

Iran is a supporter of Hamas and Hezbollah. As the assault on Gaza continues, Iran gets closer to developing its own nuclear weapons. Unfortunately, Iran's nuclear program is no longer limited by the Iran Deal, since Donald Trump withdrew the U.S. from the deal in 2018.
